I lead a team which includes one Product Manager and two Business Analysts and ensure we are all aligned on expectations and the company's overall strategic goals.

I have helped in the implementation of major Virtual Primary Care capabilities, such as our provider-led Chronic Care Management Program (including Hypertension and Weight Management conditions), as well as a task-management center for Primary Care Providers and nurses in the platform. Additionally, I have helped lead the user-experience and gathered requirements for implementing our own lab ordering capability in 2024, as well as imaging diagnostic orders. Other efforts include the implementation of Wiley Behavioral Treatment planners on our platform, which will go live in early 2024. I continue to work closely on enhancing the experience and improving both patient and provider satisfaction.

## **Mobile Product Manager**

During my time at ADT as part of the Emerging Market team, I was able to directly work and impact a brand new app on the market called SoSecure- a mobile safety app. I worked on key features in the app to bring it from introduction to growth and maturity in the market (including a Voice Activation feature to be able to initiate an emergency SOS call using a secret phrase, as well as a TrackMe feature, which allows users to set up an event and allow ADT to track them to help users feel and be safe).

I directly worked with iOS and Android developers to plan out sprints and test these features to make sure they were ready for launch. I also worked very closely with UX designers and conducted multiple usability tests to ensure that our features were being built and designed the right way. When I began at ADT, SoSecure only had very basic capabilities, but I believe I positively contributed to adding at least two of the main features that exist in the app today.

## **Associate Product Manager**

During my time at MDLIVE an opportunity opened up for an Associate Product Manager in the company, so I was able to make the move from QA Engineer into Product. Soon after having started in my new role, many of the Product Managers on my team left, so I was given a lot of responsibility really early on. Instead of shying away from this, I was able to take charge and quickly learn what was required of me to be able to be successful in this role. I took ownership of both the Patient Portal experience at MDLIVE as well as the Mobile Patient experience. I developed trust between my engineering team and worked with a mobile team of Android and iOS developers as well. I assisted in creating one of our main features in the application and web-experience (which is still a part of MDLIVE today) the Sophie AI experience for the patient to triage patients prior to their consultations. The problem we were trying to solve is that we were having a lot of patients that were not appropriate for telehealth book consultations and then get charged for meeting with a provider, even though they were being redirected to an Urgent Care or elsewhere. In order to solve for this, we worked on an AI bot that would triage patients out prior to their consults, get more information from patients to make sure they were being better and more effectively treated in our platform. I also worked on creating parity between our iOS and Android application and ensured that all features that we were working on the web platform, we also accounted for and worked on in our mobile experience.
